

The University of Melbourne (UoM): Melbourne Scholarships Office (MSO)
FORM TO REAPPLY FOR THE 2010 GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Application procedure for:

- a) international students *currently enrolled* in the UoM course for which they seek a 2010 graduate scholarship (eg MIRS, MIFRS, HRS); and
- b) local students who applied for the UoM's 2009 graduate scholarships and wish to be considered for the UoM's 2010 graduate scholarships (eg APA, MRS, FMS, HRS, Prestigious Scholarships).

If either a) or b) above apply to you, to be considered for the UoM's 2010 graduate scholarships you must complete Steps 1, 2 and 3 below by **31 October 2009.**

- Step 1** Use the **SCHOLS** online application service to submit a new application. To begin your application on SCHOLS enter your SCHOLS username and password in the 'Already registered' section of SCHOLS available at <http://pgschols.acs.unimelb.edu.au/ApplicantLogon.aspx>. If you have forgotten your 2009 SCHOLS username and password, you may request these details via the 'Already Registered' section of the website mentioned above. Contact the MSO if you're unable to use SCHOLS.
- Step 2** Complete and submit this 'Form to Reapply for a Graduate Scholarship' to the MSO.
- Step 3** Attach to this form the documents required to support your application. You may indicate below if you would like us to use documents that you provided with your application for the 2009 scholarships. If you select this option, providing you lodged all of the required documents with your 2009 application, the **only** documents that you will need to lodge are those that verify anything you have accomplished in the last 12 months that is relevant to your 2010 scholarship application (eg academic transcripts for any tertiary courses you may have completed in the last year, evidence of publications in refereed journals etc). To ascertain if there are any further documents that you need to submit, visit your SCHOLS homepage within 2 weeks of completing Steps 1 - 3.
